### Dates/Registration Times: February 05 - 06, 2016

This is a one-day racing event with Friday, February 05 reserved for on-site check-in and safety inspection from 1-5 pm. Check-in will continue on Saturday morning at 7 am followed by the drivers' briefing and the mandatory manatee safety guidelines meeting. **Streets will close at 7 am be sure that you and your crew are in place by then.** 

Insured testing will be held as the first in-water session – see the schedule for approximate times.

**LOCATION:** Race site is downtown Bradenton in the area known as the Riverwalk. The pit area is on the opposite side of the Manatee River in Palmetto at the waterfront. This race site is on Eastern Time.

**BODY OF WATER:** The Manatee River is a federal waterway, it is also an area protected by the endangered wildlife act, please act responsibly and follow all mandated regulations for this event.



You must pre-register for this event. Powerboat Superleague will accept entry blanks via fax, mail and/or email. Check for entry fee does not have to accompany your entry. **THERE IS NO MEMBERSHIP FEE HOWEVER YOU DO NEED TO FILL OUT A PROFILE FORM** (available at check-in). ## **Course and Format**

The course must comply with all insurance guidelines as well as all of the mandated manatee safety protection regulations. Please be sure to follow the protection measures that have been placed by the regulatory agencies.



Race course will be approximately 32-34 seconds; it is non-surveyed and not approved for records. TYPE: rectangular, using pillow buoys to mark turns, entrance and finish. FORMAT: time trials, followed by qualifying heats plus a final. Note that we use APBA rules and scoring guidelines to tabulate all results. DISTANCE: 15 lap qualifiers and a 30 lap final – subject to change depending on registration and prevailing weather/safety and time/schedule.

## Important Info

The race producers have asked us to share the following information – this is critical to your participation. "Last year Riverside Drive was not closed. Due to the amount of people expected for the water events and concerts scheduled in Palmetto, the Palmetto Police Department and their Safety Director have decided to close the road for the entire day from 7 am to the completion of the event for pedestrian safety. They are adamant about the 7 am deadline; no vehicles will be permitted on Riverside Drive after 7 am. No one will be permitted on Riverside Drive after 7 am. No exceptions. Only race-related personnel vehicles will be permitted to park in the pit area." **FUEL:** After multiple discussions, we will retain our current fuel policy. We will not mandate any specific fuel, VP Racing fuels remain the spec fuel for setting the fuel testing devices. There are web sites that list local availability for fuels that will pass the current fuel test. **Fuel testing is always available on-site, simply ask the inspector to test your fuel. We suggest that this be done prior to racing.**
